**SUBJECT: Training and Employment Guidance Letter (TEGL)**


1. **Purpose.** This transmits the following TEGLs:

2. **Background.** TEGLs No. 10-02 and 11-02, respectively, transmit information regarding (1) new health insurance coverage benefits and state-level responsibilities created by the Trade Adjustment Assistance Reform Act of 2002, including an announcement of the availability of funds to help states establish the systems and procedures necessary to carry out their new responsibilities, and (2) operating instructions for implementing the amended Trade Adjustment Assistance program, including the new provisions of the Trade Adjustment Assistance Reform Act of 2002, and the repeal of the North American Free Trade -Transitional Adjustment Assistance program.
