**GOVERNOR'S WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT DIRECTIVE NO. PY2002-20,  
Change 8**

**SUBJECT:** Program Year 2003 WIA Youth, Adult, and Dislocated Worker Allocations.

1. **Purpose.** This transmits two USDOL Notices of Obligation reflecting 1) the State's national WIA incentive award, and 2) a partial rescission of FY 2004 WIA Adult and Dislocated Worker program allocations.

2. **Discussion.** USDOL Grant Agreement AA-12910-03-50, Modification 3, dated March 29, 2004, reflects the States' allotment of \$77,491 in recaptured FY 2004 Dislocated Worker funds.

USDOL Grant Agreement AA-12910-03-50, Modification 4, dated June 7, 2004, reflects a 0.59 percent rescission applied against WIA Adult and Dislocated Worker funds. The State was first advised of this rescission in the Federal Register of March 25, 2004. Local areas received notice of this action under Change 7 to this Directive.

Attachment 1 conveys the appropriate adjustments to each local area's FY 2004 Dislocated Worker formula allocation amounts.

Copies of both USDOL Grant Modifications are included as Attachment 3 to this Directive.

3. **Action.** Local Area should submit the appropriate modifications to their PY 2003/FY 2004 Grant Agreement packages by July 19, 2004.


