**GOVERNOR'S WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT DIRECTIVE NO. PY2003-15, Change 4**

**SUBJECT:** Program Year 2004 WIA Youth, Adult, and Dislocated Worker Allocations

1. **Purpose.** This transmits notice of rescissions for FY 2005 WIA Adult and Dislocated Worker programs.
2. **Discussion.** The Federal Register of March 25, 2005, provides notice of reductions in the Fiscal Year (FY) 2005 component of states' Program Year 2004/Fiscal Year 2005 allotment of funds under the Workforce Investment Act. This action is taken pursuant to the Consolidated Appropriations Act, Public Law 108-477, December 8, 2004.

This appropriation requires an across-the-board reduction of 0.80 percent to all FY 2005 advance funds for the WIA, including FY 2005 advance funds for the WIA Adults and Dislocated Worker programs.

Note that this rescission affects not only local area Fiscal Year 2005 Adult and Dislocated Worker allocation amounts, but revises downwards the amounts of their respective PY 2004/FY 2005 incentive awards, as transmitted under Change 2 to this Directive.

Copies of the Federal Register notice Attachment II-A and attachment III-A, specifying states' revised FY 2005 WIA Adults and WIA Dislocated Workers funding levels, are attached to this Directive Change.

3. **Action.**
- a. The partial rescission of Fiscal Year 2005 Adult and Dislocated Worker funds affects both the corresponding Fiscal Year component of local area allocation amounts and State-level set aside totals. Among the State-level set aside totals so affected are the amounts designated for local area incentive awards.

Local areas must submit appropriate modifications to their respective PY 2004/FY 2005 WIA Grant Agreement packages to the Office of Workforce Development, Workforce Development Division prior, to **April 29, 2005.**

Replace the old Attachment 1 with the new Attachment 1. Add the new Attachment 5 and Attachment 6 following Attachment 4.
