GOVERNOR'S WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT DIRECTIVE NO. PY2004-15, Change 2

SUBJECT: Program Year 2005 WIA Youth, Adult, and Dislocated Worker Allocations

1. **Purpose.** This transmits the USDOL Notice of Obligation reflecting the July 1 availability of the full PY 2005 Youth allocation, the PY 2005 portion of the PY2005/FY2006 Adult Program and Dislocated Worker Program allocations.

2. **Discussion.** USDOL Grant Agreement AA-14660-05-55, Modification No. 1, effective date 7/01/2005, indicates the July 1, 2005 availability of the full Program Year 2005 Youth formula allocation, the Program Year 2005 portion of the Program Year 2005/Fiscal Year 2006 Adults Program allocation, and the Program Year 2005 portion of the Program Year 2005/Fiscal Year 2006 Dislocated Workers Program allocation.

This Grant Modification further indicates that, pursuant to the Jobs for Veterans Act, in order that a veteran be afforded services priority in Department of Labor-funded programs, the affected veteran must first meet that program's eligibility requirements.

Grant Modification #1 Addendum
to the WIA PY 2005 Annual Funding Agreement Clauses:

Clause 8a. Veteran's Priority Provisions: This program is subject to the provisions of the "Jobs for Veterans Act", Public Law 107-288, which provides priority of service to veterans and spouses of certain veterans for the receipt of employment, training, and placement services in any job training program directly funded, in whole or in part, by the Department of Labor. Please note that, to obtain priority service, a veteran must meet the program's eligibility requirements. ETA Training and Employment Guidance Letter (TEGL) No. 03 (September 16, 2003) provides general guidance on the scope of the veterans priority statute and its effect on current employment and training programs. DOL anticipates updating this guidance at the time of WIA reauthorization and issuing individual guidance on each affected employment and training program.
