GOVERNOR'S WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT DIRECTIVE NO. PY2004-15, Change 10

SUBJECT: Program Year 2005 WIA Adult, Youth, and Dislocated Worker Allocations

1. **Purpose.** This transmits notice of State-level PY05 Rapid Response funds made available to one local area.
2. **Discussion.** The attached correspondence documents a request by the AWIA for additional funding to help defray costs associated with operation of WIA participant programs and the State's granting of that request. Specifically, \$555,231 of Fiscal Year 2006 funds are being granted to the AWIA. Note that these Fiscal Year 2006 funds must be budgeted and tracked separately from other WIA funds available to the AWIA. Further note these funds must be fully expended by June 30, 2008.
3. **Action.**
 - a. The AWIA is granted draw-down authority for up to \$555,231 of State-level Fiscal Year 2006 Rapid Response funds. These funds may be used to provide needed WIA services to eligible Dislocated Workers.
 - b. The appropriate modification to the AWIA PY05/FY06 Grant Agreement Package should be received at the State Planning and Rapid Response Section by September 21, 2007.
 - c. Replace the old Attachment 1 with the new Attachment 1.



SUBJECT: Request for Special Allocation of Workforce Investment Act (WIA)
State Level Funds

As you're aware, the WIA Implementing Regulations (20 CFR665.340) allow for Rapid Response funds to be awarded (if any are still available after the state's Rapid Response requirements are met) to local areas that experience mass layoffs, plant closings, natural disasters, or other events if there are not adequate local dislocated worker funds to provide intensive, training, and other services. Based upon your request of August 13, 2007 (attached) and the fact that the state has sufficient funds to meet its Rapid Response requirements, it appears that all criteria have been met for a special award of these funds to be made to the Alabama Workforce Investment Area. The total amount of Rapid Response funds being made available is \$555,231.00. These are Fiscal Year 2006 funds, which must be fully expended by June 30, 2008 to prelude a reversion to the USDOL.

SUBJECT: Request for Supplemental WIA Funds

Due to a significant reduction in the amount of WIA funds allocated to the Alabama Workforce Investment Area (AWIA) for Program Year 2007 (PY07) and an increase in costs associated with funding CareerLink activities in the sixty-five county local area, we are asking that additional funding be made available to the AWIA from Governor's Set-aside funds.

AWIA has reduced the amount of funds set-aside for the adult and dislocated worker ITA program by \$2 million for PY07. We have also made adjustments to the OJT program in order to reduce costs.

Please consider this request for additional funds for AWIA in order to allow us to continue serving WIA eligible clients in the local area.
