



PORT CREDIT

Sections 40-18-400 through 40-18-403 of the Code of Alabama 1975 provide for an incentive to stimulate economic growth through new job creation, capital investment and increased cargo shipping.

BENEFIT

The Port Credit is a one-time Alabama state income tax credit of up to \$50 per TEU, \$3 per net ton of bulk cargo or \$0.04 per net kilogram of air cargo. The credit can be carried forward for five years.

The Port Credit is calculated on new cargo above 105% of the prior year's cargo.

New distribution or warehouse shippers investing at least \$20,000,000 and creating at least 75 net new jobs are eligible to receive up to \$100 per TEU over a 3-year period if entering into a project agreement with the state.

ELIGIBILITY

Eligible shippers must be engaged in manufacturing, warehousing or distribution of goods. Shippers must use a publicly-owned Alabama port. Credit allocation must be approved by the Renewal of Alabama Commission.
