INDUSTRIAL SITE, INDUSTRIAL PARK, OR RESEARCH PARK

Under Article 19 of Chapter 18 of Title 40, *Code of Alabama 1975*, as amended, a Local Economic Development Organization (“LEDO”) may apply to have an **industrial site, industrial park or research park** project be considered for funding under the Growing Alabama program for infrastructure and site improvement projects.

Eligible sites must be owned by the LEDO. Eligible industrial sites must have either a pending expression of interest or an identifiable reason an industrial prospect did not select the site. Eligible industrial or research parks must require connections to interstates, highways, roadways, rail systems, or sewer, fiber, electrical, gas, or water infrastructure.

Growing Alabama projects are funded through taxpayer contributions. Taxpayers receive an income tax credit in the amount of their contribution.
