GOVERNOR'S WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT DIRECTIVE NO. PY2006-08, Change 1

SUBJECT: Program Year 2007 and forward WIA Adult, Youth, and Dislocated Worker Incentive Funds

- 1. Purpose.** This transmits notice that State-level incentive funds made available to all local areas do not require a Plan modification to distribute funds between Program and Administration line items.
- 2. Discussion.** Incentive funds may be used for any activities allowed under WIA Title 1-B without respect to Administration or Program Costs categories. Local areas are allowed to distribute incentive funds among Program and Administration line items without submission of a Plan modification to WDD State Planning. This Directive will supersede any incentive fund modification plans from 7/1/07 forward. Please note that any incentive funds awarded must be fully expended over a period not to exceed two years from the date these funds were first made available to the State for expenditures.
- 3. Action.** Retain this Directive for future reference.
